
Indus River Water Treaty


- \cdot Signed in 1960 between India and Pakistan with the help of the World Bank (also a signatory)
- -Signed between J L Nehru (then PM of India) and Mohammad Ayub Khan (then President of Pak) in Karachi




·Widest continental shelf is of: Siberia

 - Minerals found in large amounts










Mid-oceanic Ridge first explained through Sea Floor Spreading Theory by Harry H. Hess





temperature with depth




Some local winds





- Nebular Theory, 1755: by Immanuel Kant




Insulin
