


\*In India, cyclone is formed mostly in Bay of Bengal than Arabian Sea due to freshwater influx

#### Different types of clouds

- Cirrus → At high altitude; feather clouds → Cannot form rain
- Cirrocumulus → Wool/cotton shaped clouds → Base is flat
- Cirrostratus -> In the form of layer
- Cumulonimbus -> Opaque; formed during cyclone

 Art 74: There shall be a Council of Ministers with Prime Minister to aid and advice the President

Art 75 + 89 = Art 164 (in case of State)

The Prime Minister shall be appointed by the President and the other Ministers shall be appointed by President on advice of the PM

The Ministers shall hold office during the pleasure of the President

They are collectively responsible to the house of the People

4 Oaths of the office by President


A Ministers who for any period of six consecutive month is not a member of either house of the Parliament→Upon expiration of the period shall cease to be a Minister




